- First line supervisors who need the tools and techniques to lead teams through improvement programmes.

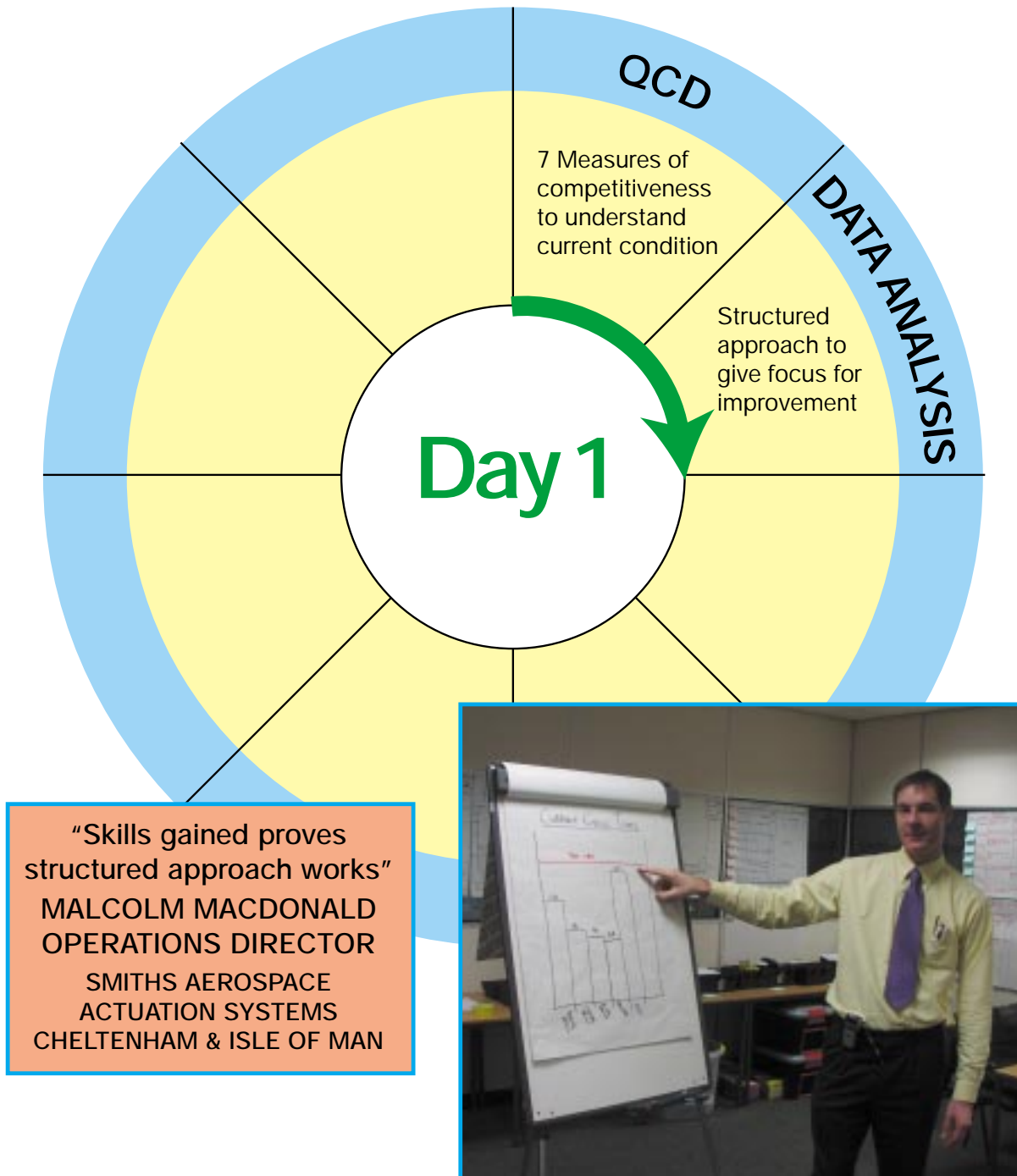
At the end of the workshop delegates will be able to:

The Real Time Workshop is very flexible. It can be run at a company's own training facility or off-site. Bookings can be taken for single company groups, or individual delegates from several companies working together.

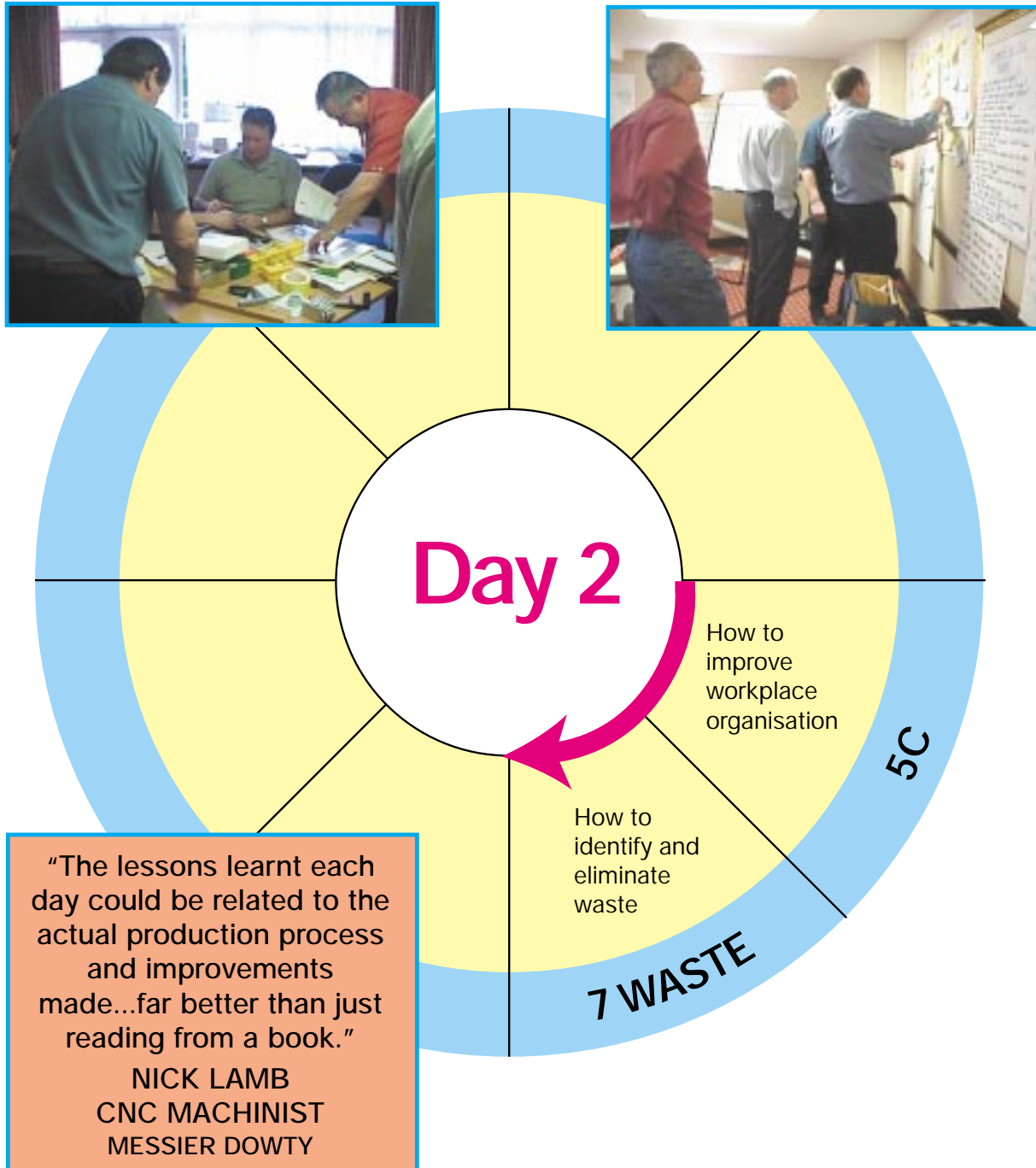
# How do I measure business performance?

# What are the improvement techniques?

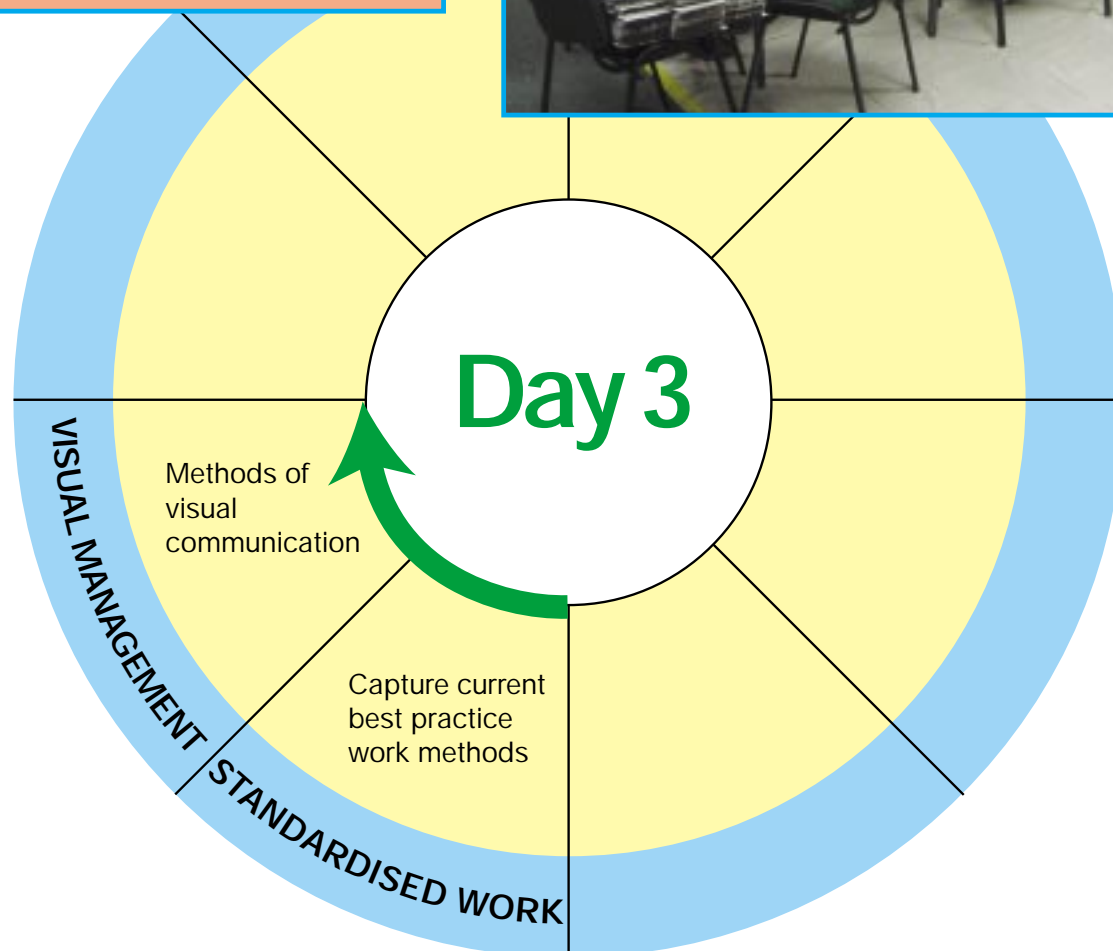
Delegates learn best practice techniques and then apply them to the cell.



# How do I assess the benefits of the improvements?

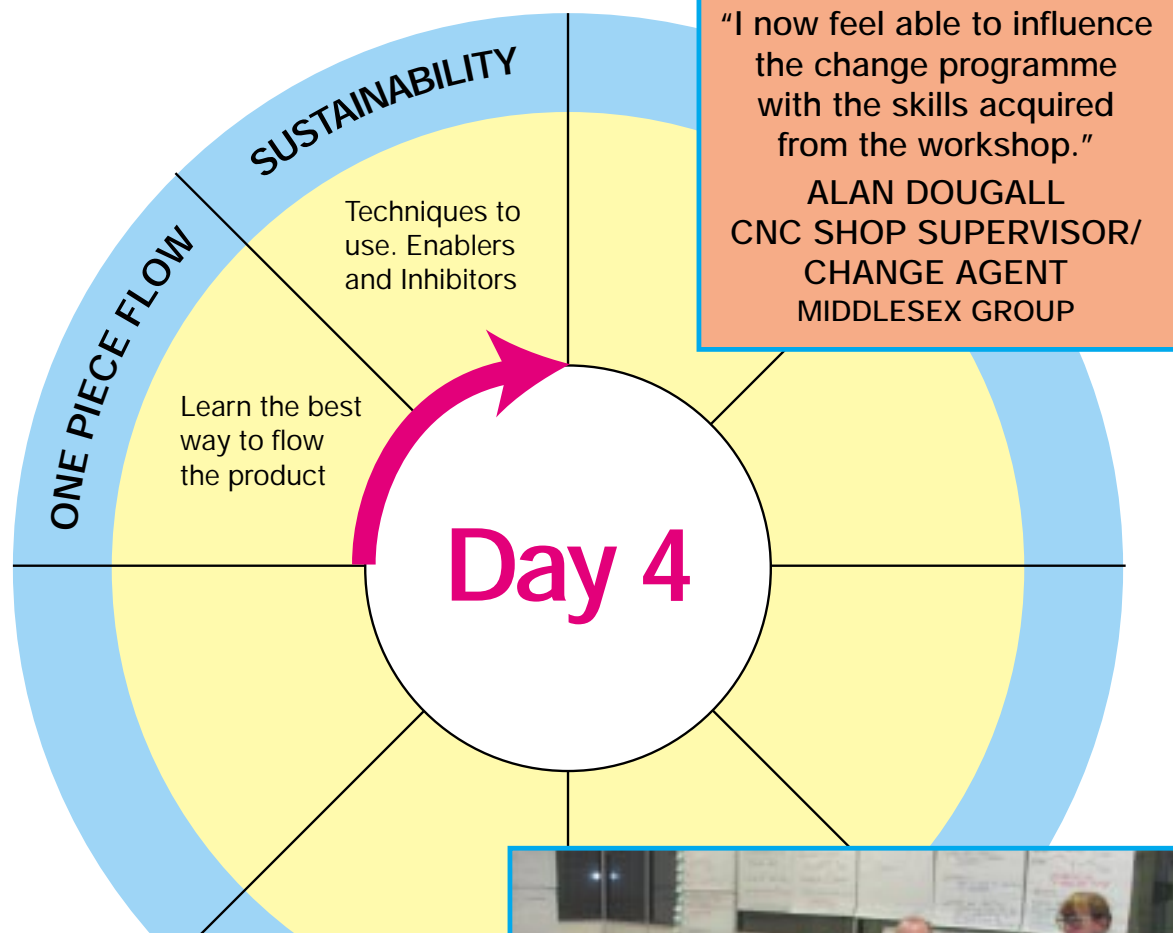
Delegates trial the improvements, measure the outputs and find the next focus area to improve.
